

SAP Garden Racket Run Regulation*

Preamble

The Racket Run activity is designed to allow children, teenagers, and adults to practice ice hockey outside of organized sports, meaning outside of clubs. The focus of Racket Run is on fun, enjoyment, and camaraderie in the sport of ice hockey. It is not a traditional training game or a competition. A minimum age of 10 years is recommended for participation.

Art. 1 Applicability of the SAP Garden Ice Skating Regulation

All provisions of the SAP Garden Ice Skating Regulation apply accordingly, unless otherwise specified in these Racket Run Regulation

Art. 2 Special Behavior Rules for Racket Run

1. The prohibitions in Article 5 Paragraph 2 c) of the SAP Garden Ice Skating Regulation do not apply to Racket Run.
2. The following additional regulations apply to Racket Run:
 - a) The following actions are prohibited:
 - aa) Slapshots
 - bb) high shots or passes
 - cc) (Body) checks or checking
 - b) Entering the ice rink is only permitted if you are constantly carrying an ice hockey stick.
 - c) Entering the ice rink is only allowed with protective equipment. An ice hockey helmet (with cage or full face shield) gloves, as well as shin guards, knee pads, and elbow pads must always be worn. Wearing other protective equipment is recommended.
3. Violations of the regulations in Article 2 Number 2 are considered serious violations according to Article 5 Number 3 of the SAP Garden Ice Skating Regulation. Supervisory staff is authorized to expel individuals from the SAP Garden who violate these rules.
